Evaluation Methods Used: Evaluation of UKG Dimensions involved a combination of automated, manual, and functional testing. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of UKG Dimensions (referred to as "in-scope features and flows") using a testing methodology that is aligned with the Web Accessibility Conformance Evaluation Methodology 1.0. Assistive technology, including a screen reader (JAWS 2022), was used along with exclusive use of the keyboard, browser zoom, manual inspection of code and review of Accessibility API output to determine support for the WCAG and Section 508 criteria. Level also functionally tested user flows with JAWS 2022.

Terms

The terms used in the Conformance Level information are defined as follows:

Overview

The UKG Dimensions™ solution is an enterprise web application that serves many different types of users, in many industries. Different customers license and configure the products in many ways. Where there are exceptions below, they may not affect all product areas.

There are some known functional areas that will not support accessibility and are not included in the WCAG report below.
Application Setup and Maintenance pages are typically opened in a new browser window and are not currently accessible to keyboard and

- Application Setup and Maintenance pages are typically opened in a new browser window and are not currently accessible to keyboard and screen reader users.
 - People Editor is considered part of system Maintenance. People records are typically maintained and imported from external systems.
 - HyperFind Editor is considered an application setup page. Users are still able to select pre-configured HyperFinds using the HyperFind Selector.



- O Source Policy dialog window in Attendance and the Leave Rule dialog window in Leave are also application setup-related pages. The "Edit Rules" function, which relies on the Leave Rule dialog window, is not currently accessible.
- Schedule Gantt view The Gantt view is not accessible. The tabular view has been optimized to provide accessible, equivalent functionality.
- Timecard grid view The grid view is not accessible. The list view has been optimized to provide accessible, equivalent functionality.
- Timecard add-on for Audits, Historical Edits, and Target Hours are not currently accessible.
- Scheduling add-ons for Indicators, Coverage, Daily Coverage, and Metrics are not currently accessible.
- Workforce-Planning Audit add-on is not currently accessible.
- Employee Self Scheduling/My Calendar The calendar view is fully not accessible. The Events/Request lists offer accessible equivalent functionality. There are also gray on gray and black on gray background and foreground colors that may be difficult to read. Indicators in this calendar may not display using inverted colors.
- Information Access Interactive Reports are not accessible. Equivalent information can be displayed via Dataviews or exported via accessible PDF format.
- Forecasting Planner and Workload Planner are not currently accessible with screen readers or keyboard only.
- Forecasting: The calendar component is not currently accessible with screen reader or keyboard only.
- The Color by Job feature contains a typical color palette that contains color selections that may reduce contrast visibility if selected.
